Abounding in history, the Charlestown
Navy Yard built, repaired and outfitted US
naval ships from 1800 to 1974. Today, it serves as a
National Historical Park and home to the world's oldest
commissioned warship—the USS Constitution. After 174 years
of innovation in sciences, manufacturing, and engineering for the
US Navy that spirit of innovation continues in the Navy Yard Plaza
with Buildings 34 and 39 offering some of Boston's most desirable office
and R&D space.

Surrounded by stunning harbor views, museums and parks, Navy Yard Plaza provides ample commercial space with the infrastructure demanded by today's corporate tenants. The unique nature of these buildings allows for a wide range of commercial uses while retaining historic and charming features such as high ceilings, large windows and exposed brick and beam architecture.

Developed by Kenney Development Company and managed by Fulton Properties, Navy Yard Plaza offers tenants outstanding accessibility to Route 1 and I-93, convenient ferry boat service to the financial district, MBTA bus route access and ample parking.


